6. Annual Program Submittal for ACTC Measure BB Funding

LAVTA staff presented the FY22/23 Annual Paratransit Program Plan, which was submitted to Alameda CTC for Measure BB funding. The plan included responses to 26 questions and spreadsheets with budget and various statistics. The plan included information about LAVTA's joint procurement with County Connection for the joint ADA paratransit operations contractor who would start providing services as of July 1, 2022. Carmen Rivera-Hendrickson asked if the new contactor will have vehicles that can accommodate oversized mobility devices. Staff replied that the current contractor has two such vehicles and if Ms. Rivera-Hendrickson knows any additional providers staff will reach out to them.

7. TAAC Recruitment

LAVTA is recruiting members and alternates to the Tri-Valley Wheels Accessible Advisory Committee for 2-year terms starting on July 1, 2022. The applications are due on April 18, 2022.

8. LAVTA SAV Update

Phase 1 of the SAV project was completed late last year and LAVTA is getting ready for Phase 2, which will have faster and more advanced vehicles. However, with the new vehicles not being available for another 18-24 months, staff is exploring an interim option using accessible vehicles.

9. PAPCO Report

Esther Waltz reported on the latest PAPCO and ParaTAC joint meeting. The items discussed were state of the system, one call / one click update, and Access Alameda website revision update.

10. Service Updates and Concerns

Carmen Rivera-Hendrickson reported that some of the newer buses (1600s and 1700s buses) have a rubber bumper near the entrance, which makes it difficult to maneuver her mobility device.

Connie Mack announced that there will be St. Patrick's Day celebrations in Dublin on the weekend of March 12 and 13. Staff said that Rt. 30 will have minor deviations on Dublin Blvd during that time. Staff will follow up with an email to TAAC members with the details of the detours.
