Projects and Services

Ridership

August typically sees ridership gains as the Tri-Valley schools starting the school year midmonth. In addition, this year two major promotions were in effect (*Youth Ride Free* and *Try Transit to School*), both of which provided free rides for students and general youth throughout the month of August. During August, the Wheels system carried approximately 126,000 unlinked boardings, representing a ~7% year-on-year (YoY) increase. This is a continuation of almost exactly the same trend from June and July.

The numbers indicate that the system continues to recover post-pandemic (and post-*Wheels-in-Motion* implementation); Weekdays saw an average of 13.8 boardings per vehicle revenue hour, a YoY increase of approximately 11%.

Wheels pre-pandemic ridership recovery with data from August 2024 compared to August 2019 is 77% on Weekdays, 100% on Saturdays and 96% on Sundays.

Bay Area Ridership Recovery

As discussed at the September Board meeting, staff have compiled several Bay Area transit agencies' ridership data, presented below.

Dublin Splatter

On September 14, Wheels operations, marketing, and customer service staff attended Splatter, welcoming hundreds of community members throughout the day. Staff answered questions, sparked great conversations, and handed out plenty of prizes through the Wheels prize wheel.



PUSD PACE Ride Along

On September 4, LAVTA staff took 25 students and teachers from the Pleasanton Unified School District's Pleasanton Adult Career Education (PACE) program on a travel training adventure. The trip started in downtown Pleasanton on Route 10R to the Livermore Transit Center. The group took Route 14 to the Wheels office for a tour and lunch, then caught Route 14 to the E. Dublin BART Station. Finally, the group rode Route 10R back downtown. This is the second year the travel training event has taken place.



Pleasanton Senior Center – September 25

On September 25, Wheels hosted a booth at the Pleasanton Senior Center at their Travel Series to assist attendees with applications for senior Clipper cards and ADA resources such as Paratransit service. Wheels also gave away promotional items and provided transit planning assistance for fixed route service destinations like shopping and medical services.

Clean Air Day – October 2

On October 2, Wheels, WestCAT, and County Connection will be fare free to celebrate Clean Air Day. California Clean Air Day is a statewide effort to engage Californians on air quality issues. For more than 5 years, this event has encouraged Californians to improve air quality through their individual actions, including through using public transit.



Pleasanton Meadowlark Dairy Detour on Route 10R- Update

On September 9, the westbound 10R resumed normal routing, reactivating four stops that had been temporarily closed due to the Meadowlark Dairy Detour. The stop on westbound Neal Street at the southern edge of Lion's Wayside Park remains closed. A new, temporary stop was placed on First Street at Lion's Wayside Park. LAVTA will be re-engaging with City and Dairy staff on a timeline for reactivating the stop on Neal Street in October.



Finance and Administration

Transportation Revenue Measure Efforts

In September, staff attended both the Transportation Revenue Measure Executive Group and Select Committee meetings where two different revenue measure scenarios were presented and discussed by MTC Staff and the consultant team. The Select Committee's feedback included a request for additional scenarios to include the ones potentially under development by the transit operators (BART, Muni, etc.) Both groups will meet again in October where the additional scenarios will be presented. The Select Committee is expected to make a recommendation on a preferred scenario at their October meeting.

California Highway Patrol Inspection

On September 22 - 23, LAVTA had its annual California Highway Patrol (CHP) audit. As part of the audit, the CHP focuses on several areas to ensure compliance with regulatory standards.

This includes inspecting vehicles and maintenance records, vehicle registration records, driver certifications, driver hour records, training, and safety protocols. This year LAVTA passed the audit without any deficiencies or findings.

Women's Transportation Seminar (WTS) Emerging Leaders Program

Kadri Kulm, Paratransit Planner, and Martha Nguyen, Senior Operations Analyst, were both selected to participate in the 2024 WTS Emerging Leaders Program. The program provides an opportunity for women to develop leadership communication skills, strategically think about their career path, and establish goals

LAVTA hosted a Dale Carnegie Communications Training September 18-20. Several staff participated along with three staff from County Connection. The training focused on developing confidence and communication skills.
